Why compost?

Dulverton Organic composts not only provide your soil with a blended C:N fertilisers but composts have the added benefit of enhancing organic content and structure of your soils. The application of DO composts will build soil structure, enhance soil biota, improve soil water retention, reduce runoff and erosion and greatly improve plant productivity.

The equation is simple, composts deliver greater environmental and productivity benefits at a more competitive price than do comparable fertilisers.

Our process

DO sources organic material for composting from across Tasmania. Blending these products with green waste in a controlled process we are able to produce composts to meet almost any customer requirements.



Input materials include garden green waste, lawn clippings, tree loppings, forestry and sawn log residues, fish and poultry wastes, biosolids, dairy wastes and organic rich liquid wastes.

Blended in a controlled process, the mixed organic material is windrow composted for 8 weeks. Temperature and moisture are closely monitored. Windrow piles are constantly aerated to maximise the composting treatment and to ensure temperatures are maintained to the exacting standards set under the Standard for Composts, Soil Conditioners and Mulches (AS4454). The site is accredited under Australian Environmental Management System Standard ISO 14,001.

The composted product is then matured for 1-2 months and finally shredded and sifted to produce a number of high grade blends ready for transport to market.

Our products

DO produces composts to meet customer needs. Our two major streams are a premium grade compost which can be used in all applications. The particle sizes of this compost can also be adjusted for specific customer requirements. This compost is ideal for agriculture, orchards, farming, vegetable growing etc. Known as "DO Premium", this material is sold throughout Tasmania to farmers providing outstanding crop growth and returns.

The second major stream 'DO Standard' is a biosolids enriched compost stream which has a more restricted application but is ideal for broad scale application in projects such as road side rehabilitation, sports fields, forestry and non contact agriculture. This compost complies with the Tasmanian Biosolids Reuse Guidelines 1999.

All of Dulverton Organics composts are competitively priced to provide users real commercial savings compared to superphosphate fertilisers.
